They present brief synopses of newspaper articles, identify the newspaper -- Eagle, Beacon or Eagle-Beacon -- in which the stories first appeared, and give exact references to the pages on which the articles are found. Microfilmed copies of these newspapers are available at the Wichita State University Libraries, the Wichita Public Library, or by interlibrary loan from the Kansas State Historical Society.

3. Fairmount College memorial gymnasium was completed yesterday and the keys turned over to the college. It will be formally opened Saturday night. The main auditorium and gymnasium floor are completed. Two large wings will be constructed later to house offices for instructors, coaches, etc. It is to be known as Memorial Hall in memory of Fairmount's dead in France.
