Content Note

The Henry Game Papers consists of his letters home to his wife in England from August 30, 1915 to September 28, 1915. The letters contain references to Zeppelins over London, weather conditions and life in the trenches. The collection also contains a photograph with the notation "Captain Henry Game" on the back.

Biography

Henry Game fought in the trenches of France during World War I. Game was a lieutenant in the 82nd Brigade and later received an assignment as Official Intelligence Officer to the Brigade.
