The Walter A. VerWiebe Papers include materials that range in date from 1916 to 1961. This includes published writings, research/subject files, photographs, artifacts and ephemera, and other materials that document the career of Walter A. VerWiebe as a field geologist, published author, and educator.

Biography

Walter A. VerWiebe was born August 26, 1887, in New York. His honored career in the field of geology included field work, teaching, and publishing. This included summer stints in Pennsylvania, and with the Ohio, Michigan, and Kansas geological survey teams. He served as Field Geologist for Roxana (Shell) Petroleum Company, and Chief Geologist for the Sinclair Oil Company in Mexico and Alaska. His teaching experience included stays at Ohio State University, 1913-1918, the University of Michigan, 1923-1927, and the University of Wichita from 1927 until his retirement in 1955. His voluminous publication record includes the standard textbook *Historical Geology and*

How Oil Is Found. Dr. VerWiebe passed away in 1961 at age 73.

Detailed Description: Series Listing
