### Content Note

The William L. Riley collection primarily concerns his military service during the Civil War from August 1862 to June 1866. He was captured once for a short duration by the Confederate Army and an account of his capture, subsequent escape, and return to his unit is contained in the collection. Two diaries kept by Riley from 1864 to 1866 provide excellent insight into the monotonous routine of military life. Another portion of the collection is concerned with Mr. Riley's application for pension in 1922 and his entire pension record is part of the collection.

### Biography

William L. Riley was born December 9, 1838. He was in the military from August 1862 until June 1866, a member of the Grand Army of the Republic. Captain Riley served most of his time based in Tennessee as a Private in Company B, 151st New York Infantry, and as a Second Lieutenant of Company C, 21st New York Cavalry. After the war, he lived in El Dorado, Kansas. He died May 3, 1922.
