#### Content Note

This collection of James W. Trimble's papers contains his congressional files from 1945 to 1967. The papers cover such issues as agriculture, the Beaver Dam, Buffalo River, Crooked Creek Dam, Farmers Home Administration, Federal Communications Commission, Indian Land Claim (Kaw), and the Office of Economic Opportunity. Also included in the collection are miscellaneous speeches, Washington correspondence, newspaper clippings and photographs.

#### Biography

James W. Trimble was born in Carroll County, Arkansas, in 1894. After graduating from the University of Arkansas in 1917, he served as a lawyer, prosecuting attorney and circuit judge. He was elected to Congress as Representative from the Third District of Arkansas in 1944 and served continuously in Congress until he was defeated for re-election in 1966. He died March 10, 1972.
