Oversized Storage	Document 1	Last will and testament of Mary Ashton: Probate of the will with a codicil of Ashton, late of the City of Lincoln, 1850.
Oversized Storage	Document 2	Last will and testament of Sarah Sharpe: Probate of the will of spinster Sharpe, late of the City of Lincoln, 1854.
Oversized Storage	Document 3	Lease agreement to a parcel of land, leased by James Whitaker to James Muttall, April 25, 1843. The document was written in the [illegible] Court of the Right Honorable Henry James, Lord Montagu, of the Manor of Accrington in the County of Lancaster, Scotland.

Oversized Storage	Document 4	Probate of the will of John Fox of Shelton Lodge in the Parish of Shelton in the County of Nottingham, deceased, dated April 1, 1891.
Oversized Storage	Document 5	Lease agreement between George Augustus Marquis of Donegalee and Thomas Ainsworth of some land in the Belfast Barony of Belfast, Ireland, December 16, 1872.
Oversized Storage	Document 6	Deed of sale of land located in Park Avenue Southport in the county of Lancaster. It was sold to Messrs. Walter and Will Lord from Messrs. Shadrack Barker, Abraham Barker and others, dated February 14, 1882.
