Content Note

Authored by John Noyes, various printed materials concerning the Oneida community comprise the major part of this collection. One issue of *The Witness*, a newspaper about the utopian community edited by its founder Noyes, is included. Most documents in the collection date from the mid-19th century; however, a brochure stating the Oneida community is "the oldest and largest manufacturer of game traps" dates from the 1920s.
