#### Content Note

Newspaper articles written by Kansas newspaper editors while visiting Mexico in 1888 were arranged together in this journal titled *Kansans in Mexico*. The editors describe Mexico's geography, industry, agriculture and social conditions. El Paso del Norte, Zacatecas, Queretaro and Mexico City were among the cities on their tour. Articles are arranged in the journal according to the newspaper in which they were published.

#### Administrative History

Kansas newspaper editors traveled to Mexico in 1888 and their respective columns were collected in the journal, *Kansans in Mexico*. Among those making the trip were A. G. Stacey of the *Kansas City Journal*; E. P. Baker of the *Topeka Commonwealth*; C. C. Baker, Kansas state printer; R. M. Field of the *Kansas City Times*; Dell Keizer of the *Topeka Capital*; R. C. Van Horn of the *Kansas City Journal*; M. M. Murdock of the *Wichita Eagle*; J. O. Campbell of the *Arkansas City Traveler*; Ed P. Greer of the *Winfield Courier*; A. P. Riddle of the *Minneapolis*

(Kansas) Messenger; Charles F. Scott of the Iola Register; Thomas A. Osborn, former governor of Kansas; C. S. Gleed, Regent of the University of Kansas; and L. C. Panizzardi of the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railroad. . A handwritten dedication in the front of the book is from C. S. Gleed to E. W. Kinsley.
