### **Literary Rights**

#### **Content Note**

The Marcel Proust Collection contains five letters written by persons who served as models for characters in *À la recherche du temps perdu*: Robert de Montesquiou (Charlus), Sarah Bernhardt (La Berma), Réjane (La Berma), le Duc de Guiche (Saint Loup) and Dr. Dieulafoy (Dr. Cottard), with an additional letter by Jacques de Lacratelle. There is also one autographed letter in longhand addressed to "Chère Madame." A typewritten copy of this letter is included. It was published in *Lettres à Madame C*.
