Scripts for such popular western shows as "Gunsmoke," "Guns of Will Sonnett," "Laramie," and "Wagon Train" are included as well as scripts for dramas such as "The Alfred Hitchcock Show," "The Jane Wyman Show," "General Electric Theatre," "The Waltons," and "Apple's Way."
